Praying For Mission

(Extract from www.cms-uk.org) Tricked and Trafficked, by Lalita Edwards in Pune, India "S has lived in our Santvana Home since September last year. She hails from a village of West Bengal. She was rescued from the Mumbai red light area by a Christian NGO because she is HIV positive and on anti-retroviral drugs. S comes from a very poor joint [extended] family. She was married to a casual labourer who could not take care of his family of eight [father, mother, his wife and four daughters and himself]. He was addicted to alcohol. One day after a thrashing from her husband S cried and said "I wish I could run away." Her mother-in-law heard her cry and released her of her sufferings only to push her into others. Her mother-in-law sold her to someone who promised her a good job in Mumbai. The family kept the older three girls and allowed S her to take her youngest child with her who was a baby. S was very happy to get away from her cruel husband but did not know that she would have to dance to the tunes of many men. Yes you have guessed right; S was sold to a brothel owner and she had to earn money for them. She stayed there five years, contracted HIV and was thrown out when she started falling sick and was pregnant. Local Christians rescued her and helped her during the last phase of her pregnancy and after that placed her here in Santvana. This is a happy ending but many young girls don't have this ending. S, Mumbai There are many more stories that can be told no age is safe. Anyone can be trafficked. **Dr Lalita Edwards is a CMS co-mission partner supported by the CMS Timothy Fund.** Pray for this work and for the supporting Fund.
